


## IMRRA's October 2020- Dry Cargo Newsletter



Dear Reader,

During September 2020, 229 Dry Cargo vessels, totalling 8,455,395 DWT, were assessed and risk rated by IMRRA's expert analysts. IMRRA identified 208 vessels as operating with the risk upper than average risk rating on the website. The highest individual risk vessel analyzed was 33% over the fleet average risk rating of 66%.


In total 87 Dry Cargo vessels (General, Container and Bulk Carrier), got involved into incidents in September 2020.





## 1. Vessels Risk Rating Above & Below Fleet Average 34%

Alarmingly, Dry Cargo vessels risk ratings continued to rise during September, up 12.5% over the previous month, to over 90.8% of vessels risk rated.

Ranking of highest traded vessels:

5,000 MT, over 25 years 50,000 to 150,000, 5-10 years 5,000 to 20,000 MT with the age 10-15 years have a third score

With physical technical vessel inspections not an option due to the pandemic, vessel safety certificates near expiry, and most importantly crew fatigue becoming a concern
